Available Support Services



Patient Education

Information and resources to help you understand the CGT process and make informed decisions.



Lodging & Housing Assistance

Assistance with eligible lodging and housing needs related to treatment and recovery.



Peer Support Connections

Opportunities to connect with individuals and families who have experience with CGT



Screening & Care Coordination

Support navigating evaluations, appointments, and treatment-related services.



Childcare Reimbursement

Assistance with eligible childcare expenses during treatment-related appointments and recovery.



Transportation Assistance

Assistance with eligible transportation expenses related to CGT appointments, treatment, and recovery. This may include parking, gas, public transportation, rideshare services, and other transportation-related needs.



Nutrition Support

Support accessing nutritional resources during treatment and recovery.
