

Sickle Cell Advocacy/legislative Update!

What?

The Sickle Cell Prevention, Care, and Treatment Program Act.

As you know, last year, we introduced the Sickle Cell Prevention, Care, and Treatment Program Act (SCPCTA) and we almost passed it. We are going to try again this year.

- On 1/29/2021 Representative Mary Flowers Re-Introduced the SCPCTA as HB362.
- On 2/9/2021 Senator Mattie Hunter Re-Introduced the SCPCTA as SB0173

Why?

The SCPCTA language is currently live in four bills:

- HB362 and;
- SB0173 and;
- Two versions of the Illinois Legislative Black Caucus' healthcare agenda legislation.
